The WorkAbility Expo program was born when the Federal Government provided funding for a series of disability employment expos across Australia as part of a package of support for new initiatives to drive better employment outcomes for people with disability, including those with high needs.

WorkAbility expos will have exhibition space for government organisations, advocacy, support services, training and other organisations that support people with disability as well as inclusive employers who are actively looking to employ people with disability.

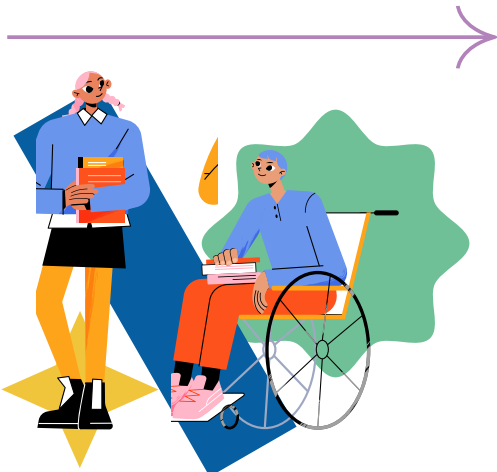
There will be a dedicated WorkAbility zone for employers to host one-on-one consultations as well as a series of workshops to help both businesses and people with disability on their employment journey.

WorkAbility expos attract a diverse audience, including job seekers with disabilities, their families and carers, service providers, government and advocacy organisations, and leaders in the disability employment space.

Each exhibitor will be given a virtual booth to hang out in for the day. We have chosen a simple style booth with large graphics – you just need to upload two images to get started.



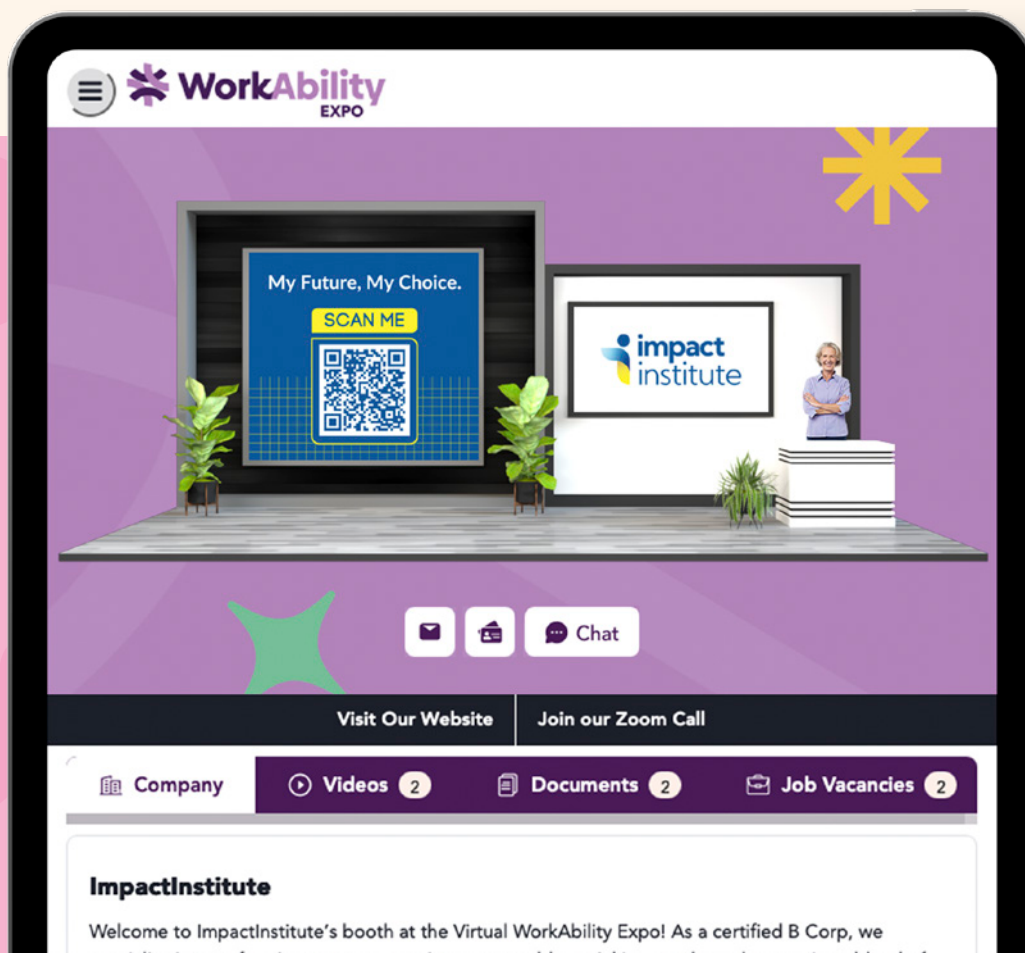
What can I do inside my booth?
